ITINERARY AS FOLLOWS:

Day 1: ARRIVE IN BANGKOK

Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to Hotel Pathumwan Princess.

Day 2: BANGKOK-KANCHANABURI – HIN TOK RIVER CAMP L/D)

Pick up from Hotel and depart for Kanchanaburi. Visit War Museum (Thailand-Burma Railway Centre), War Cemetery and the River Kwai Bridge. Arrive at Hin Tok River Camp (a luxury tented camp with air-conditioned, refrigerator and attached toilet & shower room. Lunch will be served. Visit the Hell Fire Pass Memorial and enjoy a walking tour on Trails of Death Railway from Hell Fire Pass to Hin Tok Station. Then continue to Tented Camp. Later afternoon get on a mountain bike for a visit to a nearby village or farm where you can experience bamboo basket weaving with villagers. Dinner and overnight at Hin Tok River Camp.

Day 3: HIN TOK RIVER CAMP – BANGKOK (B/L)
ANZAC DAY DAWN & COMMEMORATION SERVICES

Pick up from Hin Tok River Camp. Arrive at Hell Fire Pass Memorial Museum and walk down into Konyu Cutting. Official party arrives and walks to Memorial Site. Dawn Service commences. Return to Museum after service for official re-opening. Return to Hin Tok River Camp and prepare to attend Commemoration Service at Kanchanaburi War Cemetery. After lunch return to Bangkok and to Hotel Pathumwan Princess.

DAY 4: BANGKOK

Day at leisure.

Day 5: DEPART BANGKOK

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Australia.
