Perth to welcome NEW A330-300 from 16APR09!

Your GDS has already been updated to reflect equipment code 330, and there will be little disruption to pre-arranged seating as the configuration remains unchanged.

Services ex Perth to Thailand v.v. will now have personal monitors with Audio Visual on Demand (AVOD) in all classes. Perth is the first THAI station to receive delivery of the new A330-300 aircraft.

Suvarnabhumi Airport's BTS Skytrain station is set to commence services from 12AUG09. The 28 kilometre journey to downtown Bangkok will take only 15 minutes on an express service, or 27 minutes on a commuter service.



All THAI flights to operate from Suvarnabhumi Airport.

Effective 29MAR09, International and Domestic services will operate through the ultra-modern Bangkok hub. The last domestic service from Don Mueang will be 28MAR09. GDS systems have been updated with this change.
